



Parking FAQs

Q. How do I get a parking permit?

A. Parking permits are valid for the entire academic year. All members of the campus community who plan to park a vehicle on campus must display a valid PSC parking permit. Parking permits may be purchased during Student Services Days prior to the start of each semester in the Church-McKee Auditorium. Once classes have begun, permits may be purchased by going to the University Police Office and obtaining a permit and then going to Cashier Services for Office of Student Accounts located on the 100-level of the Administration Building to actually pay for your permit.

Q. I am a residence hall student. Where may I park?

A. With your valid parking permit displayed, you may park in any College-provided parking areas designated in blue on the campus map (Lots A-1 through A-6).

Q. I am a commuter student. Do I need to purchase a parking permit?

A. All vehicles parked in College-provided parking areas must display a valid parking permit.

With your valid parking permit displayed, you may park in any College-provided parking areas designated in gold (Lots C-1 through C-7) and in blue (Lots A-1 through A-6) on the campus map.

Q. Where can I get more information about parking on the Potomac State campus?

A. Refer to the Parking Regulations/Motor Vehicles section in the Student Handbook at **www.potomacstatecollege.edu**, under Campus Life. Information is also available from the University Police Office at 304-788-6930.

Q. Can I park on City streets adjacent to campus?

A. Parking on City streets adjacent to campus is permitted from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Vehicles parked on the street after 4 p.m. could be ticketed and towed by the City of Keyser. Don't take a chance! Park in a College-provided lot.
